#### **Submission options**

**Full papers** (12-15 pages, excluding references) are expected to report on new research that makes a substantial technical contribution to the field.

Short papers (8 pages max., excluding references) can report on research in progress or other issues of interest to the AI community. Examples of work suitable for short paper submissions include important implementation techniques; novel interesting benchmark problems; short experimental studies; position or challenge papers etc.

All papers will be subject to blind peer review based on the standard criteria of relevance, the significance of results, originality of ideas, soundness, and quality of the presentation.
